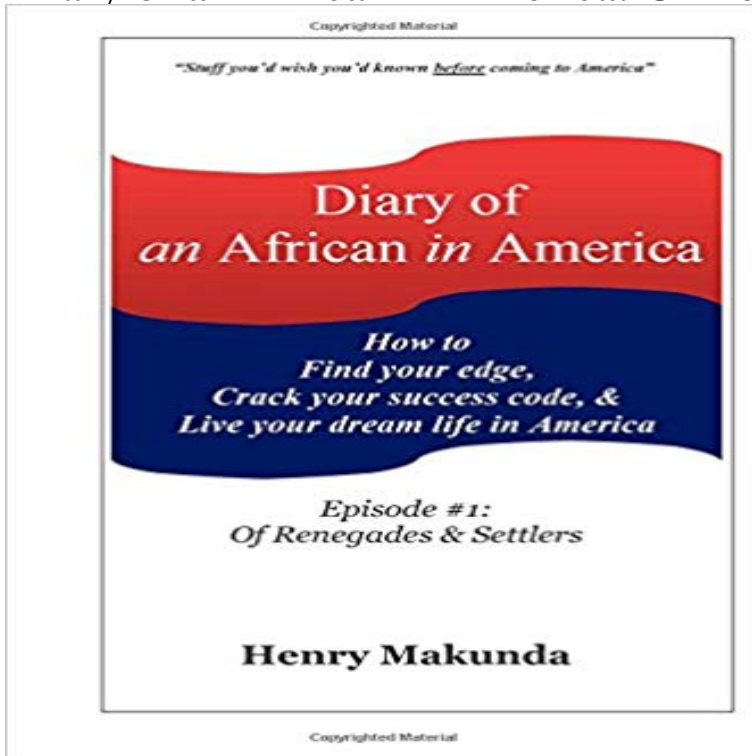


# Diary of an African in America: Of Renegades & Settlers (Volume 1)
