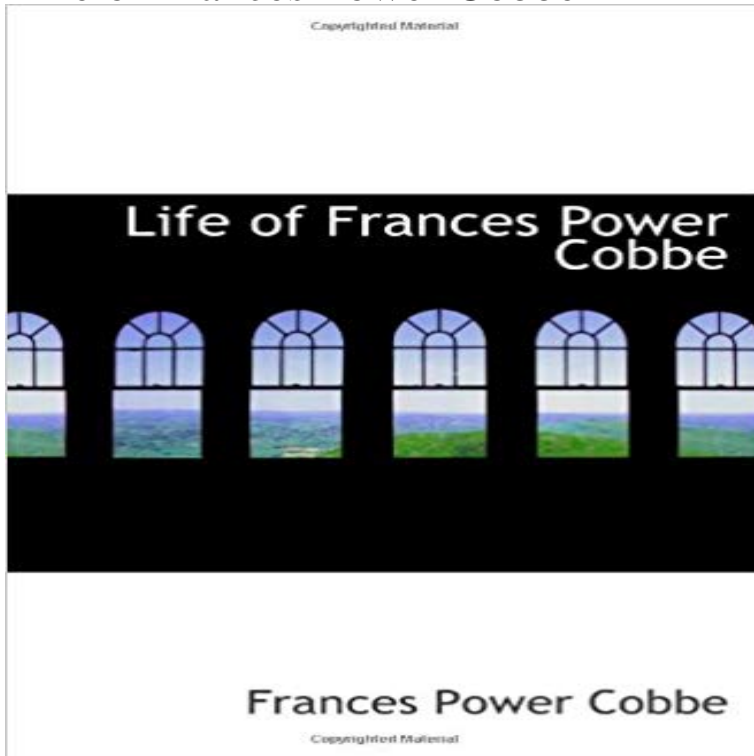


# Life of Frances Power Cobbe
