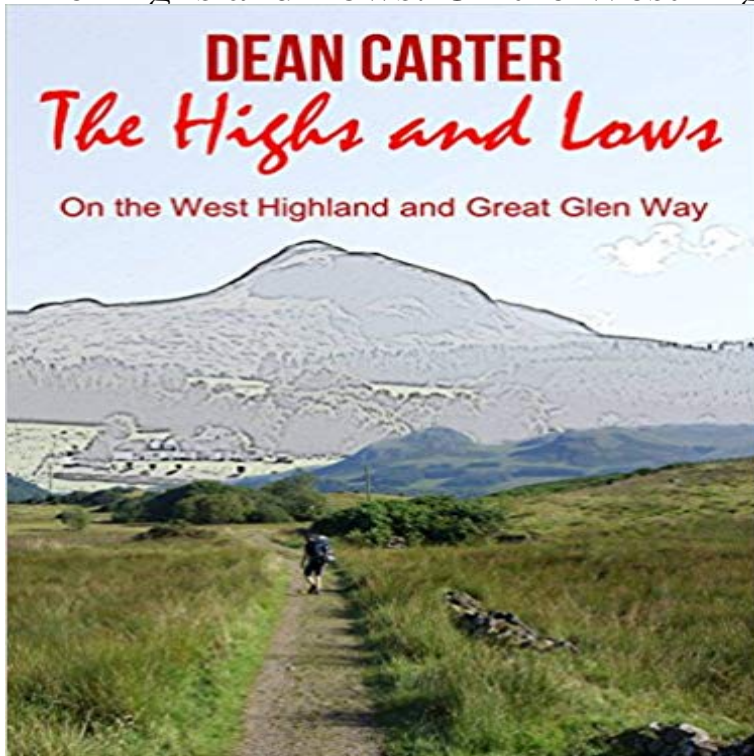


The Highs and Lows: On the West Highland and Great Glen Way
