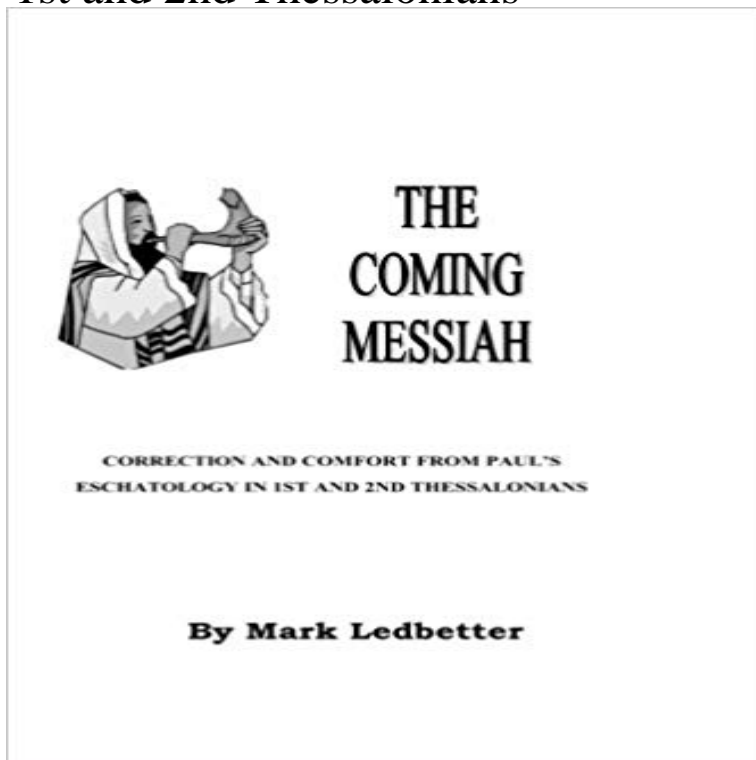


# The Coming Messiah: Comfort and Correction from Pauls Eschatology in 1st and 2nd Thessalonians
