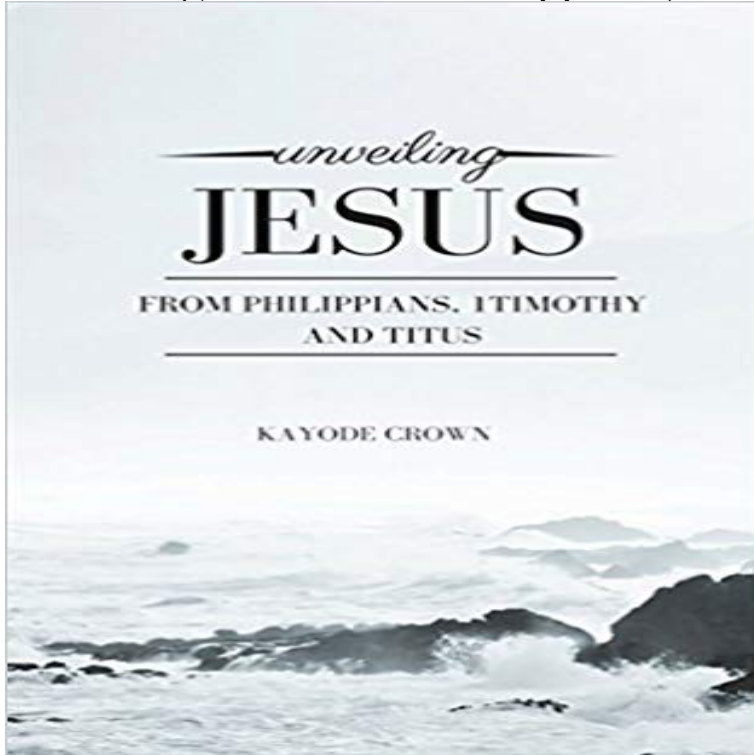


Unveiling Jesus From Philippians, 1Timothy and Titus
