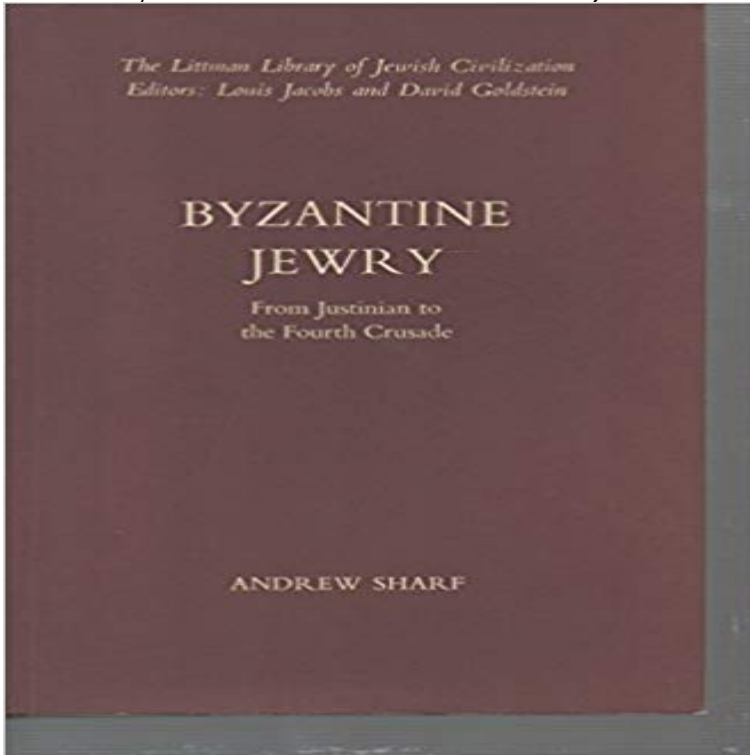


## Byzantine Jewry from Justinian to the Fourth Crusade (The Littman Library of Jewish Civilization)
