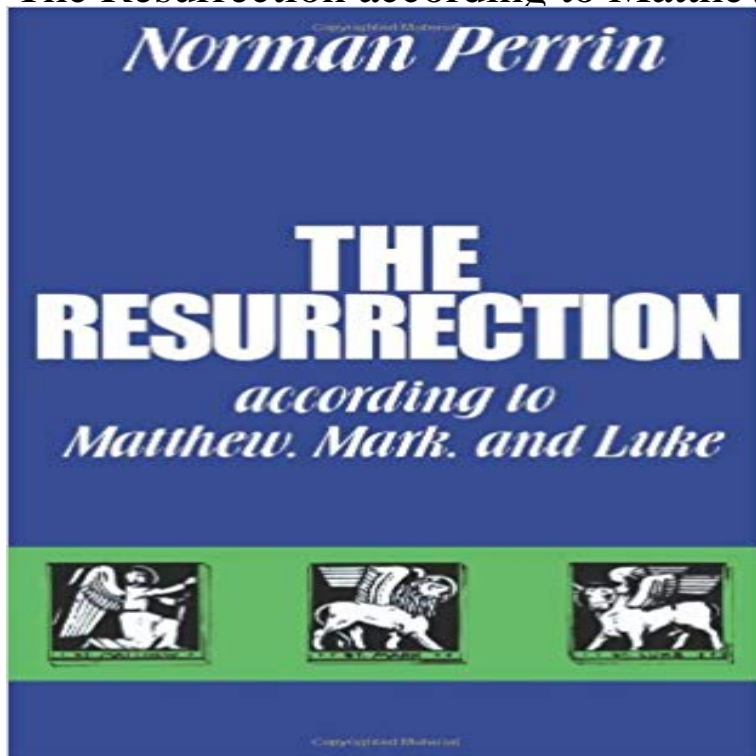


## The Resurrection according to Matthew, Mark and Luke
