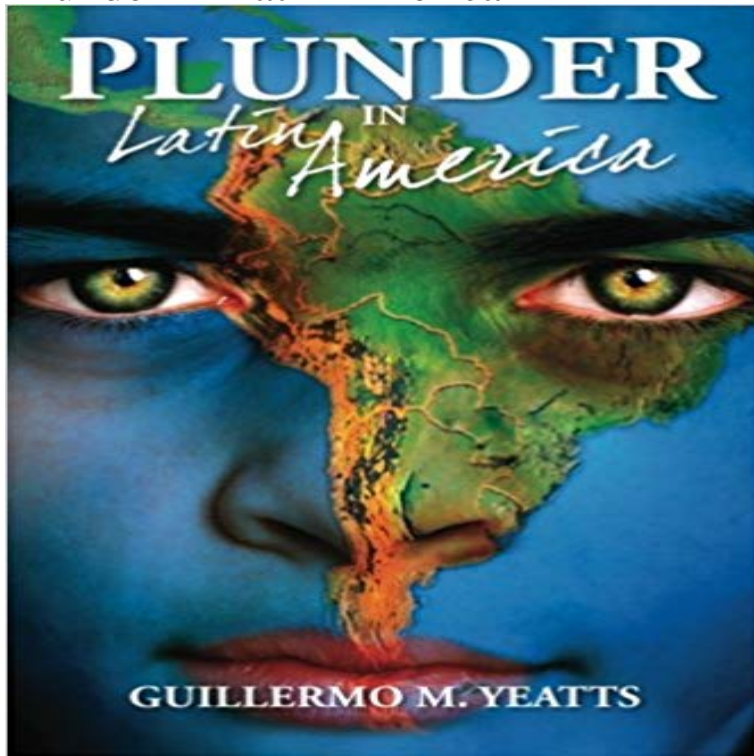


Plunder in Latin America
