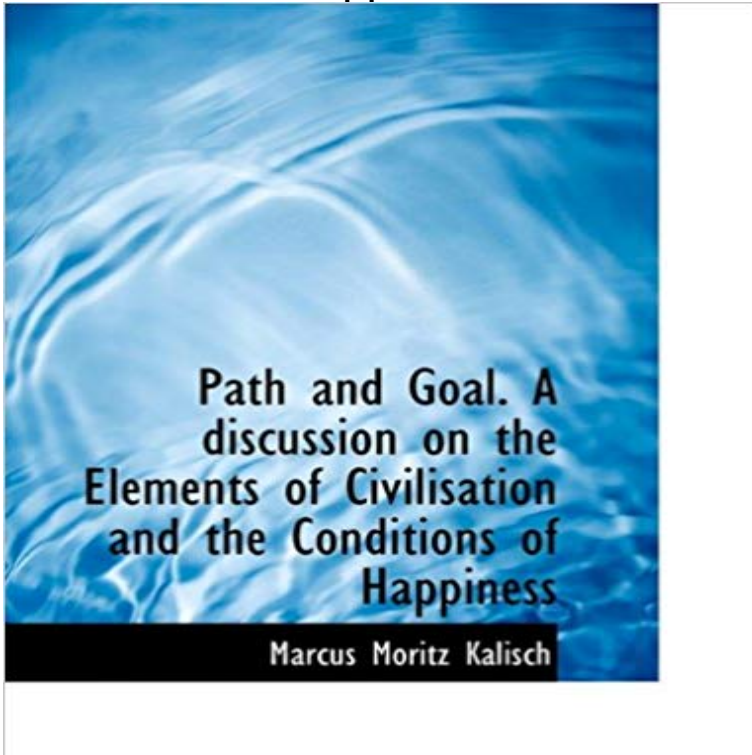


# Path and Goal. a Discussion on the Elements of Civilisation and the Conditions of Happiness
