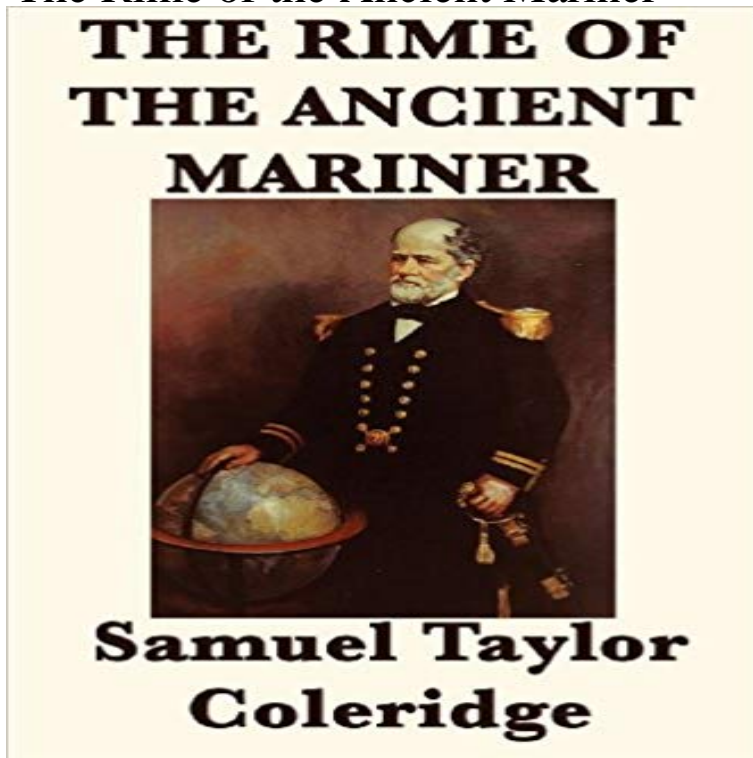


The Rime of the Ancient Mariner
