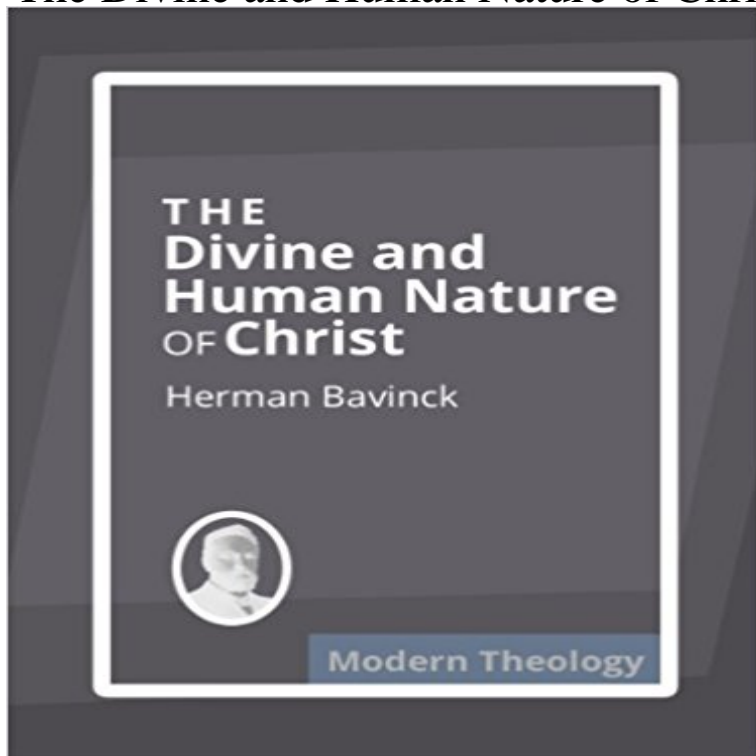


The Divine and Human Nature of Christ
